Xue Yanqun was born in China and received a master's degree in fine arts in 1989. He was a professor at Lu Xun Academy of Fine Arts. Xue's works are influenced not only by early Italian Renaissance painters but also by traditional Chinese meticulous figure painting, which has a strong oriental artistic appeal. His early works are all based on Asian women, showing their restrained beauty and elegance. He now paints numerous portraits and figures in his studio in Vancouver. His paintings have profound and solid sketch skills and the performance skills of traditional

oil paintings. Xue Yanqun's works have been published, detailed, and introduced by art publications such as "International Artist", "Connoisseur", "Contemporary International Artist", "Portrait of World Top Figures", "World Contemporary Art", etc. More than 200 works have participated in art exhibitions held in China and around the world. Six works were auctioned at Hong Kong Christie's Art Auction, and nearly 300 works were collected by the National Art Museum of China, overseas academic institutions, and private collectors around the world.





Xue Yanqun completed the graduate study and received a Master of Fine Art in 1989, he was a professor and the member of Chinese Artist's Association. More than 260 of his works have been shown in China and overseas exhibitions since 1984. He won a silver medal, two bronze and some honorary rewards in these exhibitions. Six pieces of his works were shown and sold in the auctions of Christie's Swire in Hongkong and Taipei. More than 300 pieces of his oil paintings have been collected by Chinese National Art Gallery and overseas art galleries and private collectors.
